

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AUTHORIZATION TO CONDUCT SENIOR CITIZENS RECREATIONAL BINGO

Dear Ms. Lemois:

This certificate of approval authorizes the above individual of **Benjamin Church M Tenants Association**, located at 1014 Hope Street, Apt. W5, Bristol, RI 02809, to conduct Scitizens recreational bingo for its members/residents, with total daily prizes not to exceed at 1014 Hope Street, Bristol, Rhode Island, on Fridays.

Your organization has been assigned **File No. 522**. All correspondence with the Division of Police must include your designated file number.

This authorization is granted under Sections 11-19-30 through 11-19-41 of the General Larkhode Island, 1956 as amended. No one under the age of eighteen (18) shall be allowed participate in the game of bingo. The game, which is for recreational purposes, shall be only to members/residents of the complex and their guests, clarified as follows: I RESIDENT IS ALLOWED TO PURCHASE OR REQUEST AN ADMISSION TICKET FOR ONE GLOWHICH MUST CLEARLY INDICATE THAT THE HOLDER IS A GUEST AND MUST BE PURCHAAT LEAST THREE HOURS PRIOR TO THE START OF THE GAME.

It is understood that your organization will comply with the bingo laws and the Rules Regulations set forth by the Rhode Island State Police pertaining to the game of bingo. proceeds of the game shall be used for bona fide charitable purposes. Detailed financial recoff gross and net receipts for each bingo occasion, as well as expenses and use of bingo from the state by your organization for a period of at least three years. Said records shall be a available to the State Police, upon request.

This certificate of approval is valid until **August 31, 2026.** You must present this certificate approval to your local licensing authority (Town/City Hall), if required, so that a license missued for the particular bingo game or games.
