In addition to the striping, please re-stencil the handicap symbol on each of the spaces where the handicap signs are placed and re-stencil "NO PARKING" in the space in front of the walkway apron to the church grounds. Finally place a "No Parking Anytime" sign on a post just to the south of the apron.

It is hoped that these markings will be repainted, in the future, as necessary.
