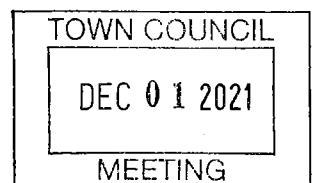

Dom Franco called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

1. October meeting minutes were approved.
2. Roger Williams Univ. Presentation – our recommendation sent to Council and item is now off our agenda.
3. Mooring Inspector Guidelines – Jenn will send completed guide lines to all and item is completed and off our agenda.
4. Harbor Management Plan – Diane W advises she received a great e-mail from Kevin Cute. We are 100% consistent and ready for approval with CRMC. He is waiting for a review from Statewide Planning and expects that within a couple of weeks. He doesn't foresee any substantive issues from that review. So, if all goes well, she thinks we should have our 5-year plan approval in short order!
5. Review of Latest Marina Proposal – fuel dock nearing completion & we're waiting on delivery of tanks & pumping equipment. We should be pumping in Nov. The new slips should be completed and operating in May of 2022.
6. CRMC – no notices or projects received for Bristol.

 - F. Wait List for Marina – 160+ names & still growing.
 - G. Dinghy Dock Winter Rates – waiting until next season, Discuss at December meeting.
 - H. Winter Rates for Dinghy Racks – will be incorporated in 2022 rates.
 - I. Gibson Rd ROW Ramp Repair – Ed Tanner working on with BHIA. Update?
 - J. ROWS – Steve C advises Town continues working on upgrading.
 - K. State St Parking Lot – Police Dept will work on striping parking lot when Fuel Dock is complete.
8. Ferry Rd Signage – Kevin Cute advises we're just waiting to hear from DOT and we'll be free to have the signage installed immediately afterward.
