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Description of proposed work:
We would like to replace the wood 2x material on either side of the door with material that will match the brownstone look that is on the landing and the brownstone that was utilized for the steps. Upon review of the existing conditions it is clear that as the landing broke down sleepers were added to the top at both sides to allow for replacement with wood 2xs to create what is currently there. The current foundation that is below the wood material shows signs that it had been cleaned out in order to create room for the sleepers in order to make a less costly repair when the original landing failed.

Property History
JOHN W. BOURN HOUSE 1804: Bourn, a wealthy shipmaster whose firm, Bourn & Marshall, owned 42 vessels, built this fine brick house. A 2-story, 5-bay Federal house with end chimneys, it has a facade elaborated by a slightly projecting, pedimented central entrance pavilion. At the second level of this bay is one of Bristol's few Palladian windows. In the late 1970s, sandblasting caused severe damage to the surface of the brick.
