Property History
GEORGE DEVOLHOUSE 1811: This 2-story, 5-bay, hip-roof Federal house with corner quoins is attributed to Russell Warren; it is typical of his early work. Two nearly identical entrances have wooden elliptical fanlights supported by half round, Doric columns on high bases. Twentieth century additions include a 2-story wing with a garage, offset at the north side, and a 2-story porch and conservatory on the south side.
