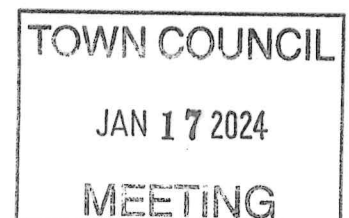

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

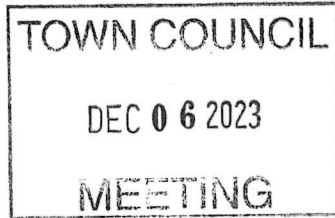
