Property History
SAMUEL W. CHURCH HOUSES c. 1855: In 1851 Church, a ship owner and owner of the wharf across Thames Street, bought this land. Both numbers 484, a small, end-gable-roof Greek Revival cottage with paneled conner pilasters, and 482, a 2-1/2-story, end-gable-roof, shingled storehouse, were probably moved from Church Wharf about 1855, to permit construction of the railroad depot.
