  - A. New Marina Status – Gregg expects cable to arrive momentarily and will update water and waste disposal to be complete in April.
  - B. State St Ramp & Ind Park Launch Docks – both are in permitting & Gregg to update plans.
  - C. Dock Repair & Maintenance – progress continues with improving weather.
  - D. Maritime Center Sign for Building – anticipate Spring installation.
  - E. Wait List for Marina – 163 names on list.
  - F. Gibson Rd. ROW Ramp Repair or Replace – Ed Tanner continues working with BHIA. Likely Fall Project in Capital Budget after July 1.
  - G. ROW Projects - Town continues upgrades with Pare engineering involved. Update from Gregg & Ed Tanner.
  - H. Fales Rd ROW Marker – Gregg M continues work with DPW. Ramp needs crack repairs. Fall budget?
4. Breakwater Study Committee – Update from Steve Janaurio.

5. Elks Club Letters – Elks Club has been advised to refer to Council who have received the complete file. Gregg M has indicated that he would not likely be in favor of the request for 8 Town Slips from the Elks.
