NARRATIVE / GIST

On 03/14/2026 at approximately 1446 hours I responded to the lobby of Bristol Police Headquarters to speak with Jason Pacheco [REDACTED] in regard to property damage sustained during the cleanup of the past blizzard.

Upon arrival I spoke with Pacheco in the lobby of Police Headquarters. He advised on 03/02/2026 he arrived home to 27 Noyes Ave and observed his landscape timbers and brick walkway were broken. Pacheco provided me with pictures of the property damage where observed damage consistent with his statement. The landscape timbers directly border Noyes Ave, and Pacheco placed 48-inch, high visibility markers so that the border of the street and the timbers were distinguishable. Pacheco advised he believes the damage to have been caused by a DPW plow truck during the blizzard clean up.

Pacheco advised that he sent an email to Bristol DPW on 03/12/2026 explaining the incident and attaching photographs of the damage but had not received a reply. Pacheco later contacted the Bristol Town Hall and spoke with a clerk who advised him to file a Police report.

Pacheco was advised the incident would be documented, pictures of the property damage have been uploaded into this report.
