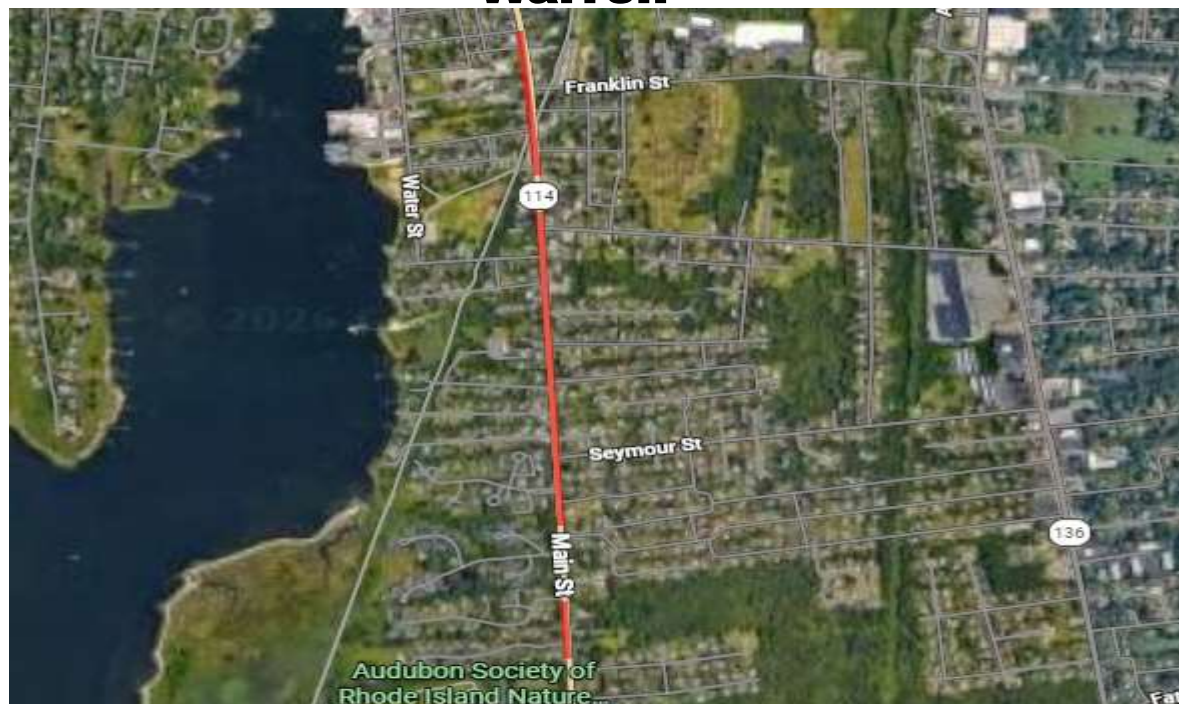


# Pavement Improvements Main Street (Route 114) Warren



## What's happening?

The Rhode Island Department of Transportation (RIDOT) is beginning the Main Street (Route 114) Warren Pavement Improvement Project. The 2026 construction season includes but is not limited to drainage repairs, traffic signal replacement and safety improvements. Additionally, substandard sidewalks will be removed and reconstructed at selected locations. Existing trees in conflict with federally mandated ADA sidewalk compliance will be removed and replaced with a more appropriate species.

The limits of the project are a one-mile stretch of Main Street (Route 114) in Warren from Wheaton Street to the Bristol Town line at Hanley Farm Road.

## When is it happening?

Work starts the week of March 30 on the western side of Main St at the Bristol town line moving northward. Hours of operation are Monday thru Friday 6:00 am to 9:00 am and 3:00 pm-7:00 pm for road shoulder and sidewalk work. In road work 9:00 am-3:00 pm includes but is not limited to drainage activity.

Future work includes milling and paving in the 2027 construction season. Updates to follow.

Operations have a planned completion timeline of Fall 2027
