To the Honorable Town Council of the Town of
Bristol: The undersigned hereby respectfully
requested of your Honorable Body that:

Stone Harbour Condominiums requests that a pedestrian crosswalk be placed on the north corner of the intersection of Bradford and Thames Streets. Drivers regularly ignore the stop signs at this intersection, posing a safety risk to pedestrians crossing the street.

The signs are, at present, a cautionary tale. A crosswalk will make the crossing more visible. Delivery vehicles frequently park in the southbound lane, obstructing the stop sign. Installing an additional stop sign in the northbound lane would be beneficial.

With the completion of the former Robin Rug complex, traffic on Thames Street will increase significantly, exacerbating potential safety concerns.
