The Department of Revenue has received The Town of Bristol's *Notice of Proposed Property Tax Rate Change* for fiscal year 2026-2027. The Department has reviewed the manner upon which the notice was computed and finds that it meets the requirements of both Regulation 280-RICR-40-00-1: *Standards and Procedures for Property Tax and Fiscal Disclosure for Rhode Island Cities and Towns* and R.I. Gen. Laws §§ 44-5-11.8. Your notice is hereby approved.

Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws §44-5-2 (c) please submit to the Division of Municipal Finance, within thirty (30) days of the final action by city council, the adopted tax levy, tax rate, and all information relating to any changes in the levy and or tax rate that may have occurred since the date of this letter.

Please be advised that, per R.I. Gen. Laws §§ 44-35-6 and 44-35-7, the *Notice of Proposed Property Tax Rate Change* and *Report to Taxpayers on the Current and Proposed Budget* must appear in a newspaper of general circulation at least ten calendar days prior to the meeting to consider the budget and that the *Notice of Proposed Property Tax Rate Change* and the *Report to Taxpayers on the Current and Proposed Budget* should conform to all applicable local charter provisions.
