Congregational Street, north side, one space across from the driveway of 38 Congregational Street.

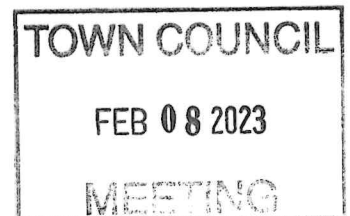

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

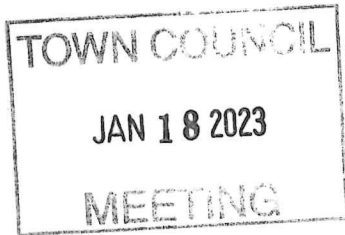
