Remove floating docks, piles, one existing fixed pier, and remove/relocate 11 moorings within the proposed marina area. Establish a marina perimeter limit (MPL) with 75 authorized slips. Installation of a fixed pier extension, new wave fencing along outside perimeter of existing main pier, new concrete floating docks along perimeter of proposed marina basin, new floating docks and steel piles within the interior of the marina basin, and a new marine pump out location.



A notice of the time and place of such hearing will be furnished you as soon as possible after receipt of your request for hearing. If you desire to request a hearing, to receive consideration, it should be in writing (**with your correct mailing address, e-mail address and valid contact number**) and be received at this office on or before **March 4, 2026**.
