To Members of the Bristol Town Council:

Happy New Year!

This is in response to the Council's recent advertisement in the Bristol Phoenix seeking applicants to fill an appointment to the Bristol County Water Authority.

I have served as a member of the BCWA Board of Directors for the last eight years. I have been the Chairman of the Board for the last three years. I also served as Vice-Chairman previously.

I am very much interested in continuing as one of the Town Council's three appointments to the BCWA Board of Directors.

As you well know, the Bristol County water supply and system operations are complex and expanding. Each year the staff completes numerous improvements to the physical water system and successfully manages large-scale engineering and construction projects throughout the three towns, including work that is proceeding on the new connection to the Pawtucket Water Supply System. These programs and projects are also supported by our financial management and customer services teams which continue to refine our procedures and operations to maximize efficiencies and result in fruitful interactions with our customers. Our finances for our operations and capital improvements are carefully planned, and we are well-positioned for the future. Rate increases have been very modest attending to present issues while at the same time providing for future needs of Bristol County. Considerable attention has been focused on increased replacements and repairs to the local water distribution system network. Our most recently completed project, the new Hope Street Pump Station (at Tupelo) has provided considerable increased-much needed water pressure to a significant portion of the Town.

As BCWA Chairman, I believe I have been provided careful, strategic, frugal and professional guidance to the Board and staff and have been a very effective representative of the Town of Bristol. On a monthly basis, I provide written summary updates of the BCWA's activities and programs to the members of the Bristol Town Council as well as to those in Warren and Barrington. I have also appeared before the Council to provide updates about BCWA.

Thank you for the opportunity to serve the Town of Bristol. I hope I can continue my service serving the Town on the BCWA Board of Directors.
