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**CHAPTER 16 – MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC**

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**ARTICLE IX. – RESIDENTIAL PARKING**

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**Sec. 16-345. - Designated residential parking streets.**

(a) The following streets are designated as residential parking streets, daily, during the hours of five p.m. to seven a.m.:

Bradford Street, from Hope Street to ~~Central~~ High Street;

(b) The following streets are designated as residential parking streets, daily, 24 hours.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

The Town Council will be in session in the Town Hall, Council Chambers, on June 3, 2026. If remonstrance in the meantime, a petition bearing the valid signatures of at least twenty (20) qualified voters must be filed with the Town Clerk requesting a Public Hearing, such hearing must be held before final action may be taken on said ordinance.
