Ryan Avenue, east side, from a point two (2) feet south of utility pole # 2 to fifteen (15) feet northbound.

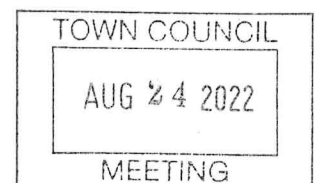

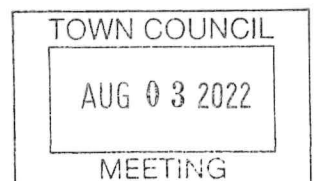
