



## August Water Department Report

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We worked on the 8in water main in the Clark complex. K&R was able to cut and cap the main by the hydrant on the corner of Randy's building. This was the last of the water projects downtown.

Installed new pit meter and water service line due to leak.

We are marking water service valves for potholing; this is the next phase of the DSMI. We have approximately 1000 services to pothole.

We have completed our 2025 monitoring samples which are required by EGLE. All Samples came back good. This year we sampled Total Trihalomethanes-Haloacetic Acids,Nitrate,PFAS, and Uranium.

All Bacti samples and reports this month for EGLE are completed and summited.

We completed shut offs this month and hung door cards for residents on the shut off list.

We are working on meters that are not reading properly.

Ryan has been taking classes for his test coming up in November. I also took a cyber security class.

Plenty of Miss Digs and reports again this month, mostly around the downtown area.



## September Water Department Report

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Installed new service line for two houses that were galvanized.

We have been marking water services for the contractor doing the potholing, they have been making good progress so far.

Marked 47 miss digs for the month.

There have been several work orders this past month for shut off, water complaints, or faulty equipment.

Sent letters out to Fifty-five residents to see if we could possibly use their house for Lead and Copper sampling next year for EGLE compliance.

Completed all necessary sampling for the month and necessary reports to EGLE for compliance.

Ryan Young has been going to classes getting ready for his water exams in November.

Completed another round of water shut offs for non-payments.



## October Water Department Report

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We have completed all the monthly requirements with EGLE to stay in compliance for the month of October.

We have been working on fixing meters that have not been sending readings. Finding some with broken wires or MXU was knocked off.

Replaced a couple of pit meters and repaired the pit structure.

Egle did a visit to inspect the well sites. I will receive a report in a couple weeks of their visit.

Still marking water shut offs for the crew to pot hole for our CDSMI report. They are more than halfway thru the town.

Working on the Lead/Copper sample plan for EGLE. I need 40 houses that must fit the criteria to be eligible for a sample site.

Ryan will be taking his S-4 D-4 water exam November 4th.

He has been taking classes, and I have been studying with him.
