The City of Buchanan is considering a Michigan Department of Natural Resources (DNR) Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund (MNRTF) grant application to fund the McCoy's Creek Trail Extension in Buchanan.

A Public Hearing has been set for Monday, March 14, 2022, at 7:00 p.m. at Buchanan City Hall, 302 N. Redbud Trail, Buchanan, Michigan 49107. The purpose of the Public Hearing is for the City Commission to receive public comment regarding the submittal of a Michigan Department of Natural Resources (DNR) Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund (MNRTF) grant application to fund the McCoy's Creek Trail Extension Project in Buchanan

The McCoy's Creek Trail Extension Project is the development of an approximately 0.7-mile extension of the existing McCoy's Creek Trail, an existing non-motorized walking, biking, and running trail in Buchanan. The project will extend the existing McCoy's Creek Trail from EB Clark Woods to Walton Road over St. Joseph River bridge and to River St. Joe Brewery in the City of Buchanan and the Township of Buchanan in Berrien County.
