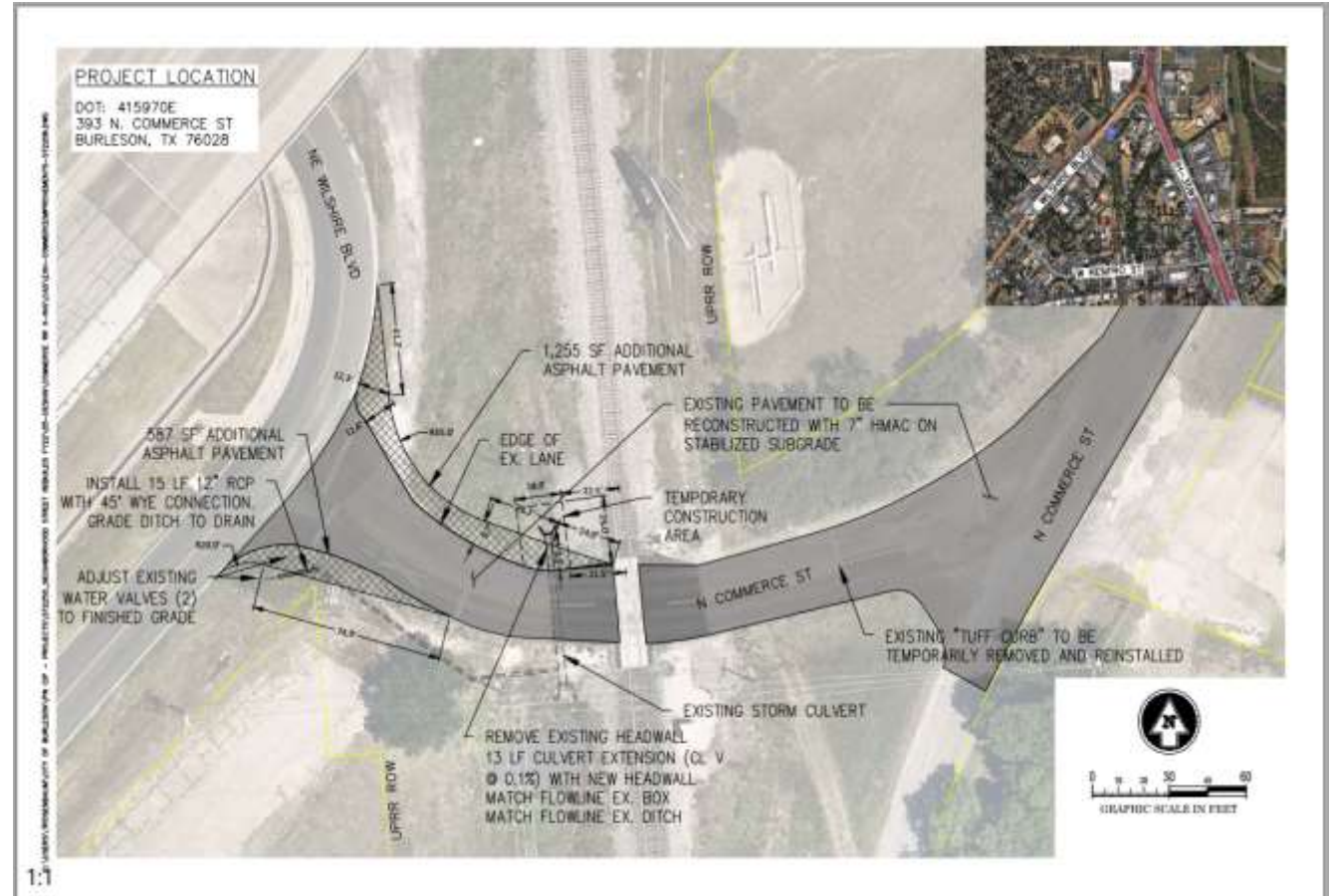


Neighborhood Street Rebuilds FY22 Project

Project Overview

- The Neighborhood Street Rebuilds FY22 (ST2250) was awarded to Texas Material Group, Inc., dba Texas Bit on May 15, 2023.
- The project included the repaving of N. Commerce St. from the I-35W Service Rd. to the SH 174 Service Rd.
- The improvements to N. Commerce St. included modifications to the N. Commerce St. at the UPRR crossing.
- These improvements include extending an existing storm drain box culvert and widen the pavement width to improve condition for the turning movements of large trucks.
- Because this portion of N. Commerce St. is located within UPRR rights-of-way, a permit was required from UPRR for the work. The improvements included modifications to the actual crossing by UPRR contractors. The modification to the crossing is the addition of one crossing panel. The City of Burleson is responsible the costs of these improvements.
- The proposed improvements were sent to UPRR for review. UPRR has issued a revised permit with associated costs. Upon approval by council and final issuance of the executed permit, work can begin on the proposed improvements.
