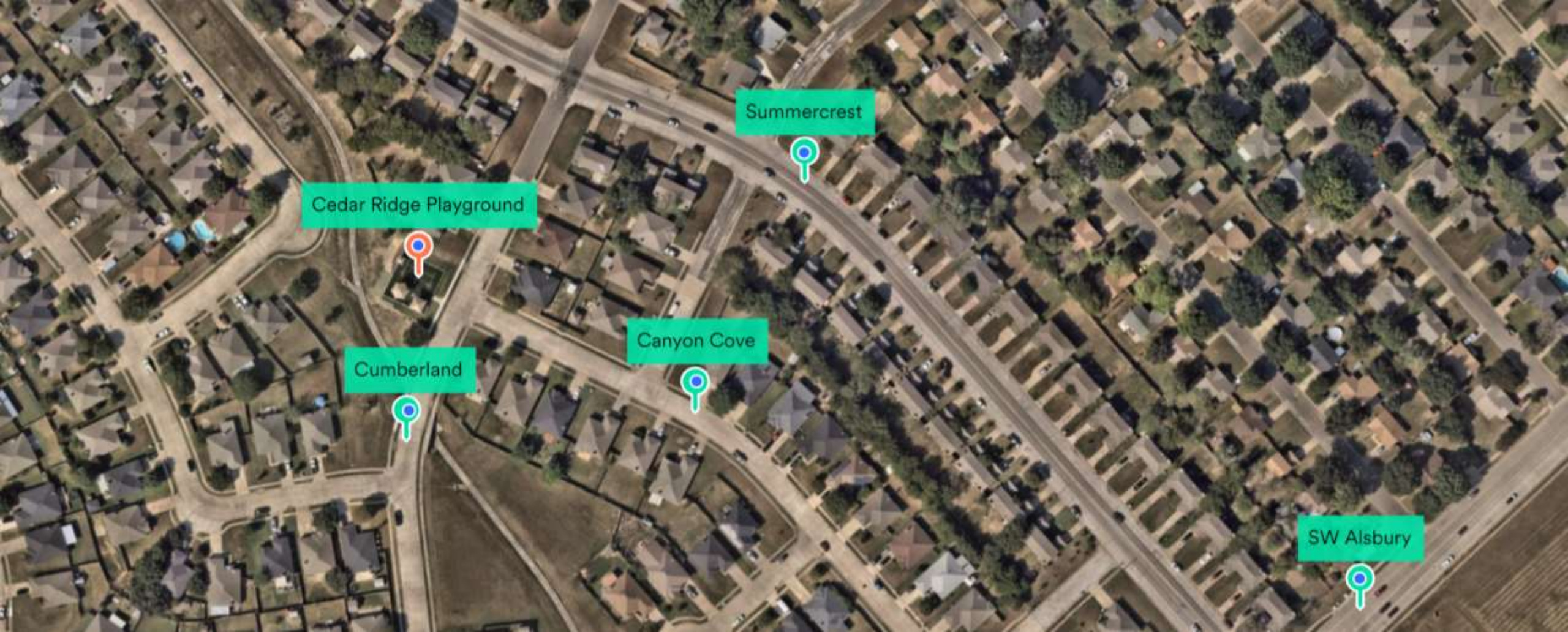




# Cedar Ridge Park Access Improvements – Policy 17

# Overview

# Existing Conditions

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Staff reviewed the area of concern and noted the following:

- Recent playground renovation was recently completed
- Traffic operations do not support converting the intersection to all-way stop intersection control
- Mid-block crosswalk not recommended within 100 feet of the Canyon Cove intersection
- Multiple park patrons indicated a desire for off-street parking for the site

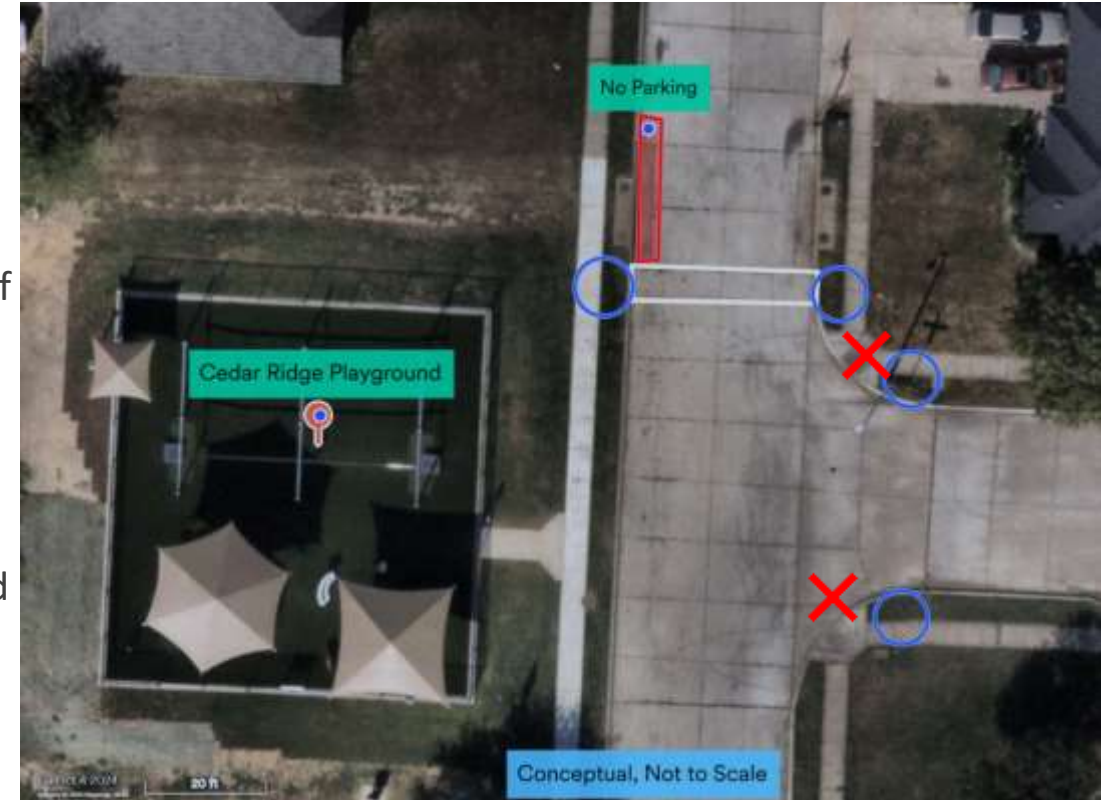
# Request, Suggested Scope, and Estimated Cost

Request: Add a ramp to assist disabled patrons get to the park from the sidewalks along Canyon Cove and the east side of Cumberland

## Suggested Scope:

- Removing two diagonal ADA ramps (NE and SE corners of the Cumberland / Canyon Cove intersection)
- Installing four directional ADA ramps (NW, NE (2), and SE corners of the intersection)
- Installing a crosswalk and corresponding signage for this configuration
- Installing pavement markings to discourage parking on southbound Cumberland approaching the new crosswalk

Estimated cost: \$16,500 from Street Maintenance operating budget
