New Election Equipment

- Current ES&S M-100 equipment out of compliance end of 2024
 - Purchased in 2007
 - New requirements can not be retrofitted to current M-100
- Compared ES&S and Hart Intercivic Optical Scan
 - Similar function nothing wrong with either one
 - Hart had better options for the City of Burleson
- Hart features that stood out
 - Lower ballot box ADA compliant
 - Required unique number assigned to cast ballot already programmed to perform not need to upgrade in 2 years
 - Portable cart easier for election workers to use
 - Tarrant County uses these machines
- Texas Secretary of State must approve
 - Already received approved
- Continue to use paper ballots
