SUMMARY:

On December 21, 2023, a petition was submitted by Jeffrey Brister (owner) to be released from the extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) of the City of Burleson on approximately 1.03 acres of land known as Lot 8, Block 10, of Blackberry Springs, Phase II, as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

The petition for release from the ETJ is administratively complete and meets the requirements of H.B. 5217 and Subchapter D, Chapter 42 of the Texas Local Government Code.
