

Amendment to Wholesale Water Agreement with City of Fort Worth

City Council December 11, 2023



Background

- Burleson has contracted with Fort Worth for water services since 1963
 Current contract term: January 1, 2011 September 30, 2031
- Two Entry-Points
 - West side entry-point allows up to ten million gallons per day (MGD)
 - East side entry-point allows up to two million gallons per day (MGD)
- Proposed amendment has two very important objectives
 - Establish City participation in design and construction of the transmission main expansion project
 - Increase the City's water volume on east side entry-point from 2MGD to 13MGD

Background: Cost Sharing




 City of Fort Worth developing water transmission main expansion

 Project will increase supply capacity to wholesale customers to the south including Burleson

Project estimated to cost \$56,960,401

 Participation in costs upfront as opposed to on reimbursement basis eliminates expense of Fort Worth debt service

Project Timeline and Engineer's Estimate

- 0-60% Design: Aug 2022 to Mar 2024 \$651,211
- 60-100% Design: Mar 2024 to Mar 2025 \$831,899
- Easement Acquisition: Oct 2024 to Feb 2026 \$1,362,096
- Construction Stage 1: Aug 2025 to Aug 2027 \$6,086,298
- Construction Stage 2: July 2026 to Jan 2028 \$7,400,000

Burleson Total Estimated Cost: \$16,331,504

Burleson Funding Plan


Project included in City's Capital Improvement Plan (CIP)

- 2026 \$9,229,769

Project total in CIP plan \$16,268,426

Additional \$63,078 to be recommended in the next update to the CIP plan to coincide with current project estimates and timing





Amendment and Project Significance

- Accomplishes City Council Strategic Plan element of securing additional water supply
- Supports elements of recently adopted Water Masterplan by securing buildout water supply needs
- Complements other infrastructure projects currently underway such as the expansion of Industrial Pump Station and additional storage facility projects
