

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLESON, TEXAS, PROPOSING A TAX RATE FOR THE 2026 TAX YEAR.

WHEREAS, the City of Burleson, Texas (the “City”), is a home rule city acting under its charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 9 of the Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 82 of the City’s Home Rule Charter states that the City has the power to levy, assess, and collect an annual tax upon the taxable property within the city for any authorized municipal purpose; and

WHEREAS, Sections 26.06 and 26.061 of the Texas Tax Code require that the City give notice of the date and time of the public hearing on or the public meeting to adopt the proposed tax rate; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing on the tax rate is scheduled to take place on September 8, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Sections 26.06 and 26.061 of the Texas Tax Code stipulate that the notice of the public hearing or meeting include the names of the members of the governing body and how each member voted on the proposed tax rate; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to propose a tax rate for the 2026 tax year and give notice of the public hearing at which the proposed tax rate will be considered.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BURLESON, TEXAS, THAT:**

Section 1

The proposed tax rate for the 2026 tax year is \$_____ per \$100. The proposed tax rate is subject to final approval by the City Council.

Section 2

This Resolution shall become effective from and after its date of passage in accordance with law.
