

Burleson Parks and Recreation receive award recognition






BRiCk-Revenue



Year to Date (Accruals not included for current FY)




Golf- January Comparisons




January Revenue




Revenue YTD October - January




Golf- Pro Shop and FB Revenue Year to Date




Pro Shop Revenue YTD October - January

Food and Beverage Revenue YTD October- January




Golf- Food and Beverage Cost of Sales Percentages




Food and Beverage Cost of Sales % by Department


