SUBJECT:

Consider recommending approval of three new bike trail features funded and constructed by Fort Worth Mountain Bike Association (FWMBA) at Chisenhall Hike and Bike Trail (Staff Contact: Jessica Martinez, Deputy Director of Parks)

SUMMARY:

The Chisenhall Hike and Bike Trail system includes over 10 miles of soft-surface trails, with difficulty levels ranging from beginner to expert. As part of continued efforts to enhance rider experience and support volunteer-led improvements, the Fort Worth Mountain Bike Association (FWMBA)—a long-standing partner and active Beautification Agreement participant—has proposed the addition of three new wooden trail features, to be fully funded and constructed at no cost to the City.

Proposed Features:

Two Tabletop Jumps

Location: Cactus Jack Loop

Purpose: Provides a controlled air option for riders while maintaining trail flow

One Roller Feature

Location: Field Loop

Dimensions: 24 feet in length, with undulating curves

 Purpose: Encourages momentum-building and technical progression in a lowrisk format

Design & Safety:

- All features constructed using pressure-treated lumber and galvanized hardware
- Securely anchored and designed for beginner-to-intermediate rider progression
- Clearly marked bypass routes provided for each feature

· Reviewed and compliant with floodplain requirements

Maintenance & Oversight:

 Ongoing maintenance will be performed by FWMBA under their existing Beautification Agreement with the City.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of the proposed trail features as presented.
