

# Acquisition of Replacement Fleet and Equipment

City Council July 21, 2025

### Background



- January 22, 2025 Council Policy and Valuation Committee recommended approval of the Equipment Replacement Funds Policy
- February 17, 2025 City Council passed a resolution adopting the new policy, which includes accelerating purchases into the summer preceding the new fiscal year
- March to April 2025 Staff ERF Committee developed recommendations for FY26 replacements per the established policy
- May 7, 2025 Finance Committee recommended approval of the FY26 fleet replacement lists
- May 27, 2025 City Council endorsed the FY26 fleet replacement lists and CIP amendment that includes funding for a replacement streetsweeper for FY26

#### **Fleet Purchases**



Tonight's agenda includes several items for replacement fleet acquisitions:

- Five items for the purchase of 19 replacement units funded by the Governmental and Proprietary Equipment Replacement Funds
  - Acquisition of 11 FY25 replacements
  - Acquisition of eight FY26 replacements
- One item for the purchase of a replacement street sweeper funded in the capital program per policy (due to its cost being greater than \$300,000)

Total Funding: \$2,073,557.47

In addition, the purchase of seven replacements (one for FY25 and six for FY26) totaling \$165,187.71 are being processed administratively as their costs are within the City Manager's authority

### Recommendations / Actions Requested



#### Approve Cooperative Purchasing Agreements with:

- 1. Bobcat of North Texas for the purchase of one unit in the amount of \$118,627.42
- 2. Holt Caterpillar for the purchase of two units in the amount of \$282,795
- 3. Rush Truck Centers for the purchase of 11 units in the amount of \$798,943.95
- 4. SAMES Auto Group for the purchase of four units in the amount of \$339,517
- 5. Tiger Corp. / Bane Machinery for the purchase of one unit in the amount of \$189,099.10
- 6. TYMCO, Inc. for the purchase of one unit in the amount of \$344,575
