

BACKGROUND

336 S. DOBSON ST CHANGED OWNERSHIP - JULY 2022

- New owner requested City mow and clear the ROW
- City is responsible for maintaining ROW
- Inquired if unimproved ROW could be abandoned



BACKGROUND

STAFF REVIEW


- No plans to construct and extend roadway over the railroad and floodplain and no purpose for vehicular connectivity
- Construction of trails not included in trail master plan
- City maintenance costs reduced
- 30 feet of original 80 foot of ROW abandoned in 1974



BACKGROUND

STAFF REVIEW

- Abandonment would divide ROW into equal parts and would be offered to adjacent property owners - each adjacent property owner would receive 25 feet adjacent to their property
- The two adjacent property owners to the south are interested in retaining their equal part and had no objections to the abandonment
- Public notice of the possible abandonment was published in the Star-Telegram on September 8, 2023
