- Required redesign of retaining wall and drainage channel which modified easement
- New drainage easement to be dedicated per plat see clip from plat to the right

### EXISTING PLAT ALLOWED FOR BUILDING PERMIT - APPROVED REPLAT WILL BE FILED WHEN ABANDONMENT APPROVED
