3. BUDGET AND TAX RATE

A. CSO#5214-09-2023, ordinance adopting the budget for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 beginning October 1, 2023, and terminating September 30, 2024, and making appropriations for each fund; repealing conflicting ordinances; providing a savings clause and an effective date; and finding that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed is open to the public. This budget will raise more property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of \$2,134,839, which is an 8.8 percent increase, and of that amount \$1,485,617 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year. (Final Reading) (Staff Presenter: John Butkus, Assistant Finance Director)

John Butkus, Assistant Finance Director, presented items 3A-3H as one presentation to the city council.

B. CSO#5215-09-2023, minute order ratifying the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 annual operating budget beginning October 1, 2023, and terminating September 30, 2024. (Staff Presenter: John Butkus, Assistant Finance Director)

Motion made by Phil Anderson and seconded by Ronnie Johnson to approve.

Motion passed 7-0.

C. CSO#5216-09-2023, ordinance levying the ad valorem property tax of the City of Burleson for Tax Year 2023 on all taxable property within the corporate limits of the city on January 1, 2023, and adopting a tax rate of \$0.6325 per \$100 of valuation for Tax Year 2023; providing for revenues for payment of current municipal maintenance and operation expenses and for payment of interest and principal on outstanding City of Burleson debt; providing for enforcement of collections; repealing conflicting ordinances; providing a savings clause and an effective date; and finding that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed is open to the public. The proposed tax rate exceeds the no-new-revenue tax rate. (Final Reading) (Staff Presenter: John Butkus, Assistant Finance Director)

Motion made by Dan McClendon and seconded by Adam Russell that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.6325 cents per one hundred dollars valuation, which is effectively a 6.55% percent increase in the tax rate.
