- ✓ Serves as the Medical Director for Azle Fire and EMS continuously since 2012




Primary Roles

Burleson Centric

- Provide all independent recommendations as the exclusive source of medical direction and oversight for the Burleson EMS System
- Establish patient care standards for all EMS medical services provided within City of Burleson
- Develop medical protocols, credentialing requirements, medical policies for all medical services
- Recommend to Burleson Fire/EMS medically appropriate performance measures and standard for the City of Burleson service area, including equipment on public safety vehicles
- Provide medical direction to City of Burleson Public Safety
 Communication Center, including EMD protocols and quality assurance
- Monitor the clinical performance of Burleson Fire/EMS



Selection Process

Selection Process

Early summer FD staff and Dr. Steve Martin met with various hospital representatives, physicians, and private firms that offer Medical Director services.

Meetings served as opportunity to thoroughly discuss:

- Current EMS Services/call volumes & vision for Burleson's Fire Based response/transport model
- Expectations, roles/responsibilities for Medical Director
- Time commitment, personal willingness & availability to teach, train, ride out with BFD personnel
- Approach & experience in reviewing/resolving sentinel medical events

RFQ opened July 15, 2022

Closed August 2, 2022

Two RFQ responses submitted & evaluated by (Dr. Steve Martin, Fire Chief K.T. Freeman, Assistant Fire Chief Casey Davis, Assistant Fire Chief Josh Jacobs).



Evaluation Criteria

Qualifications: 30%

Experience on similar projects: 25%

Methodology: 20%

Interview: 20%

References: 5%



Medical Director Scope of Services:

Approximate time commitment: 500 hours annually:

Weekly

- 1-hour weekly meeting with Fire Administration
- 1-hour QAQI review
- 2-hour weekly phone calls/emails

Monthly

- 4-hours EMS Continuing Education (CE)
- 4-hour credentialing fire personnel
- 12-hour ride out

Annually

50-hours for EMS education conferences/protocol & policy revision

24-7 (365 days) coverage for On-Line Medical Control – This may be delegated to a system, or another Physician

Enhancements & Benefits to Community & Fire Personnel

The State of Art Amon G. Carter Medical Simulation Training Center will serve as an advanced training site for Burleson Fire/EMS Personnel

Texas Health Burleson is a designated hospital for Dr. Cordova to practice and will serve as the primary medical direction/control for Burleson Fire/EMS

Texas Health Burleson & Texas Health Fort Worth both will serve as sites for clinical rotation for Burleson Fire/EMS EMT's & Paramedic's



Conclusion

Staff recommends for Council to consider approval of a 5year <u>professional services contract</u> with Dr. Joseph Cordova to serve as the City of Burleson Medical Director in the amount not to exceed \$60,000. Per year
