Burleson Public Health Accomplishments: 2020-2022

Consistent Trends

- > Demand for Burleson Public Health Services Continue to decline
 - Last three months: May Aug (2022)
 - Total Vaccinations: 277 (Last 4 weeks 25 total or 8 average per week)
 - Total Tests: 1154 (Last 4 weeks 317 total or 79 average per week)
- Providers & Supplies for Covid testing, vaccines, treatment, general information are readily available
- Economy of scale to provide Burleson Public Health Services no longer efficient use of funding

Transition of Services Recommendation

- Staff recommends discontinuing public health services on October 28th, 2022. Public health staff has been notified of the recommendation.
- Current services include vaccines, testing, and employee guidance on positive tests and exposures to COVID-19.
- Council appointed Dr. Martin to a two-year term as the City's public health authority. Dr. Martin's contract will continue for the duration of his term to ensure availability for consultation as needed.
