WHAT'S IN THE CONTRACT



MULTI YEAR CONTRACT

- Contract Approved in 2019 for a (5) Five Year term
- One (5) Five Year Renewal Available in 2024



ANNUAL PRICING INCREASE

- Allowed Once per Year per the Current Contract
- Labor and Fuel are calculated separately
- Administration and Franchise Fees remain the same



GARBAGE COLLECTION

- (2) Twice per week collection
- Residents allowed to use their own container



RECYCLING COLLECTION

- 65 Gallon



SMALL BULK & BRUSH

- Under (3) Three cubic yards
- Collected Weekly



LARGE BULK & BRUSH

- Collected Monthly by Zone



LANDFILL

- 2 Vouchers / Year Included

CONSUMER PRICE INDEX INCREASE



ANNUAL INCREASE BY CONTRACT

- Increases to Fuel and Labor calculated using formulas defined in the contract.
- Labor Formula uses information from the U.S. Bureau of Labor.
- Fuel Formula uses information from the U.S. Energy Administration.



PROPOSED INCREASE

- Proposed increase = 10%,
- This is consistent with previous assumed increase.
- Costs will be absorbed from revenue within the Solid Waste Fund (not General Fund).
- No increase to customer fee schedule.



CUSTOMER RATES

The City will absorb the rate increase from the Solid Waste Fund with no change for citizens.

Contract Rate increase absorbed by the Solid Waste Fund FY 22/23: 10%

Contract Rate increase absorbed by the Solid Waste Fund FY 21/22: 4%
