SUBJECT:

Consider and take possible action on a resolution approving settlement participation form to participate in the settlement of the State of Texas opioid litigation through the Texas Attorney General's Office with Alvogen, Amneal, Apotex, Hikma, Indivior, Mylan, Sun, and Zydus and authorizing the City Manager to execute all necessary documents in connection with the same. *(Staff Contact: Matt Ribitzki, Sr. Deputy City Attorney/Legal Services Director)*

SUMMARY:

Texas, along with a broad coalition of states and subdivisions, has now reached final agreements with fifteen companies to resolve legal claims for their role in the opioid crisis. The newest agreement is with Alvogen, Amneal, Apotex, Hikma, Indivior, Mylan, Sun, and Zydus.

To be eligible to participate, the City must return the required subdivision participation form to the Attorney General by September 30, 2025.
