Notes:

2. Have discussions with TXDOT included the sign as proposed? Yes. This has been discussed and approved by Emilio Sanchez, Assistant director via email correspondence with TXDOT
3. Indicate the distance that the sign extends beyond the property line. The sign does not extend beyond the property line.
4. Sign location indicates that it will extend into the easement and a Easement Use Agreement will need to be obtained prior to any permits being issued. We have moved the sign and attached the new drawing. It will not extend.
5. Sign is proposed to be 18' instead of the allowed 9'. Yes. QT just put up a sign 1 block up that is taller than we are proposing.
