SUBJECT:

Consider and take possible action on a Cooperative Purchasing Agreement with Sames Auto Group through TIPS Cooperative (Contract # 240901) for the purchase of five replacement vehicles in the amount of \$414,686.89. (*Staff Contact: Tray Gee, Fleet Superintendent*)

SUMMARY:

This item includes the purchase of five replacement Police Tahoe SUVs funded in the Governmental Equipment Replacement Fund for FY27. These units were approved for replacement by council action on June 15, 2026. They support daily public safety service delivery at a combined cost of \$414,686.89.

On February 17, 2025, City Council approved a resolution establishing the Equipment Replacement Fund (ERF) Program to support long-term financial sustainability and ensure sufficient funding for the timely replacement of vehicles and equipment. As part of this initiative, departments with ERF-covered assets, in collaboration with representatives from Finance, Purchasing, and the Fleet Division, participated in an internal review committee. The committee evaluated and prioritized vehicles for replacement based on the criteria outlined in the ERF policy.

The internal committee representatives consisted of:

Over the course of several meetings between January and March 2026, the ERF Committee reviewed its role and objectives, finalized replacement request forms, coordinated with departments regarding eligible replacement units, and evaluated all submitted requests. Following detailed discussion of each submission, committee members independently ranked the requests by replacement priority, and the results were compiled into an average prioritization ranking for each unit.

The compiled rankings were presented to the City Manager on April 20 and May 4, 2026. Based on this input, the City Manager developed a recommended list of replacements for review by the City Council Finance Committee. City Council approved the list of vehicles and equipment on June 15, 2026.

These purchases are being made through The TIPS Cooperative, contract number 240901, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Chapter 271, Subchapter F. Cooperative contracts are competitively solicited on behalf of multiple governmental entities, and the City may utilize these contracts to achieve cost savings and efficiency. Staff has confirmed that the cooperative contract was procured in compliance with applicable requirements. In addition, staff compared the proposed vendor's pricing with available cooperative contracts, and concluded that the recommended vendor offers the most competitive pricing available to the City.
