

## **RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS,** the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Burleson, TX that the bullet-Resistant Components for Law Enforcement Vehicles project be operated for FY2026; and

**WHEREAS,** the City Council agrees that in the event of the loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full. and

**WHEREAS,** the City Council designates the City Manager, Tommy Ludwig, as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

### **SECTION 1**

The City here by approves the submission of the grant application for the Bullet-Resistant Components for Law Enforcement Vehicles Project to the Office of the Governor.

The City Manager, or their designee, has the authority to sign any documents necessary for the grant.
