SUMMARY:

South Fox Lane was designed and constructed from East Renfro Street, south towards East Hidden Creek Parkway between 2004 and 2006. South Fox Lane was annexed into the City of Burleson in 2008. At that time, discussion did occur regarding connecting South Fox Lane to East Hidden Creek Parkway, but the neighborhood did not favor the connection and circulated a petition in opposition. Although contractors were engaged to provide pricing, no action was taken to move forward with the connection.

There is an existing low water crossing located on South Fox Lane approximately 475 feet south of East Renfro Street. This crossing regularly floods during rain events, leaving the South Fox Lane residents with no means of ingress/egress. To alleviate this issue, staff has developed and evaluated potential options for connecting South Fox Lane with East Hidden Creek Parkway. The two build options will require an engineered design, right-of-way acquisition and the award of a construction contract.
