RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLESON, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF TWO GRANT AWARDS FROM THE TEXAS A&M FOREST SERVICE TOTALING \$120,000 TO SUPPORT THE CITY'S URBAN FORESTRY INITIATIVES.

WHEREAS, the City of Burleson Parks and Recreation Department applied to the Texas A&M Forest Service for two Community Forestry Grants on February 11, 2025, and received notice of award on June 13, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded two grants totaling \$120,000, consisting of a \$20,000 Canopy for Community Resilience Tree Planting Initiative (one-year grant) and a \$100,000 Urban Forester position grant distributed over three years; and

WHEREAS, the Tree Planting Initiative will fund the planting of 40 native and adaptive trees in high-traffic and underserved areas to support canopy restoration, improve pedestrian comfort, and enhance community engagement; and

WHEREAS, the Urban Forester grant will support the creation of a dedicated Urban Forester position responsible for tree inventory, maintenance schedules, planting events, public education, and integration of sustainable forestry practices; and

WHEREAS, both grants are incorporated into the proposed FY 2025 budget, and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it to be in the best interest of the residents of Burleson to accept these grants in support of long-term urban canopy expansion, resilience, and environmental equity;

NOW THEREFOR E, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLESON, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1.

That the City of Burleson hereby accepts the grant awards from the Texas A&M Forest Service totaling \$120,000, with \$20,000 designated for the one-year Canopy for Community Resilience Tree Planting Initiative and \$100,000 designated to support the Urban Forester position over three years.

Section 2.

That the City Manager, or their designee, is authorized to take all necessary actions to implement the grants, including execution of any required agreements or documents with the Texas A&M Forest Service.

Section 3.

This resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
