<u>SECTION 3.</u> The City Manager, or his designee, may draft appropriate resolutions or ordinances in support or opposition for legislation as outlined in the 2025 State Legislative Program.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> The Mayor and City Council, City Manager, and City Staff may provide testimony in support or opposition for legislation as outlined in the 2025 State Legislative Program.
