

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLESON, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING CITY OF BURLESON STREET CLOSURES FOR AN ANNUAL FALL FESTIVAL HOSTED BY OPEN DOOR CHURCH.

WHEREAS, the City of Burleson, Texas (“City”), is a home rule city acting under its charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 9 of the Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, under Chapter 70 of the Code of Ordinances, the event organizer must be approved by the Burleson City Council due to the proposed closing or impacting a public street; and

WHEREAS, the parade organizer, Open Door Church, requests certain streets (Clark St./Miller St. and Rigney Way/Scott St.) in the city limits be closed at certain times for the annual event; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the matter, the City Council desires to approve the closure of certain streets as set forth in Exhibit A, on October 23, 2026, from approximately 5 p.m. to 9 p.m.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLESON, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1.

The City Manager or his appointee(s) is authorized to provide approval of necessary street closures for the Annual Fall Fest as set forth in Exhibit A.

Section 2.

This resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
