

## **ORDINANCE**

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE CITY OF BURLESON YOUTH PROGRAMS STANDARDS OF CARE; FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS ORDINANCE IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; PROVIDING A CUMULATIVE CLAUSE, A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Burleson, Texas, is a home rule city acting under its charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 9 of the Local Government Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Human Resources Code, Section 42.041(b)(14), establishes requirements for exempting recreational programs operated by municipalities for elementary age (5-13) children from childcare licensing requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to receive exempt status for a youth recreation program, a municipality must adopt standards of care by ordinance after a public hearing for the program, then submit a copy of program standards, a notice of the public hearing for the program and a copy of the ordinance adopting the standards to the State; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has reviewed proposed standards of care that include staffing ratios, minimum staff qualifications, minimum facility, health, and safety standards, and mechanisms for monitoring and enforcing the adopted local standards; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council held a public hearing on this matter prior to the adoption of this ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that the youth programs standards of care will provide basic child care regulations for day camp activities operated by the City of Burleson in accordance with Section 42.041(b)(14) of the Texas Human Resources Code;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLESON, TEXAS, THAT:**

### **Section 1.**

The City Council hereby adopts the City of Burleson Youth Programs Standards of Care for providing basic child care regulations for day camp activities operated by the City of Burleson. A substantial copy of the City of Burleson Youth Programs Standards of Care is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein for all purposes.

**Section 2.**

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed is open to the public and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.

**Section 3.**

This ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of the City Code and other ordinances of the City of Burleson, Texas, except where the provisions of this ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of other ordinances, in which event the conflicting provisions of the other ordinances are hereby repealed.

**Section 4.**

The terms and provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be severable and that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance and the remainder of such ordinance shall continue in full force and effect the same as if such invalid or unconstitutional provision had never been a part hereof.

**Section 5.**

The City Secretary shall provide for the publication of this ordinance after its passage and as provided by law.

**Section 6.**

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
