SUMMARY:

As part of the construction of the Police Headquarters Renovation and Expansion project, the city requires testing of multiple materials to verify that the earthwork and materials meet standards. Staff reached out to UES, who has been used on previous projects to assist in the request. Staff initially entered into an agreement for Phase 1 work, and is now requesting an amendment to allow for continued work on the full project.
