SUBJECT:

Consider approval of a Resolution canvassing the November 5, 2024 Special Local Option Election. *(Staff Presenter: Monica Solko, Deputy City Secretary)*

SUMMARY:

The City Council duly ordered a Special Election to be held on November 5, 2024 in accordance with Texas Election Code. The Special Local Option Election is to authorize the legal sale of all alcoholic beverages for off-premise consumption only. The election was conducted by Johnson and Tarrant Counties and the unofficial tallies sent over to the City Secretary's office. The unofficial results received from Johnson and Tarrant Counties are as follows:

There are a few outstanding military ballots. If the ballots are received by the deadline, the results could potentially change prior to canvass. If the ballots are returned in accordance with state law and the Early Voting Ballot Board qualifies the ballots, the unofficial results will be updated to reflect any changes. The City Council will be provided with a revised resolution prior to the canvass.

Council is asked to review the tally and accept the tabulation and approve the Resolution officially canvassing the election.
