SUBJECT:

Consider approval of a minute order ratifying resolution 4B111323ParksRecreation Capital, requesting the City Council pass an intention to reimburse resolution that includes an amount not to exceed \$2,833,601 related to the design, construction and improvements for Parks and Recreation capital projects. (Staff Presenter: John Butkus, Finance Director)

SUMMARY:

On September 11, 2023, Council approved the final reading of the City's FY23-24 budget and capital improvement plan. On September 18, 2023, Council approved a revised Parks and Recreation capital plan. This reimbursement resolution will give the City the ability to begin incurring capital expenditures with the intent to reimburse the cost incurred with proceeds from bond debt to be issued at a future date.
