BUDGET

Green Ribbon is a reimbursement grant. The grant requires design and construction administration to be completed by the municipality and the cost of construction will be funded through the grant.

Design contract with Kimley-Horn- \$115,000 with contingency

Grant Award-\$440,358 Green Ribbon

GCAA (Previously Awarded)-\$250,000

Total Estimated Project Cost-\$805,358
