

## **RESOLUTION**

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLESON, TEXAS, NAMING THE COMMUNITY PARK “BURLESON LEGACY PARK”; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Burleson, Texas (“City”), is a home rule city acting under its charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 9 of the Local Government Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has acquired land generally located at the intersection of Alsbury Blvd and Hulen St (the “Tract”); and

**WHEREAS**, at this time the City Council and City plan to use the Tract for a variety of different potential purposes, including recreational uses, such as a community park, and non-recreational uses, such as economic development uses and housing non-recreational City facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has engaged design professionals to help plan the different possible City uses of the Tract, and the City and its design professionals are still currently engaging in that process; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to name the potential community park that may be a part of the Tract without dedicating any portion of the Tract, implicitly or explicitly, as a public park or recreational area; and

**WHEREAS**, in May 2025, City Council directed City staff to initiate a naming process for the potential community park consistent with prior community-driven naming efforts; and

**WHEREAS**, City staff implemented a public engagement process that allowed residents to submit proposed names for the potential community park and provide input, resulting in significant community participation; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 20, 2025, City Council reviewed the results of the public naming process and discussed the submitted names and overall project vision; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council determined that the name “Burleson Legacy Park” appropriately reflects the intent of the potential community park as a one-of-a-kind destination that honors the community’s history, people, and long-term impact while looking toward the future; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to name the potential community park “Burleson Legacy Park” without dedicating any portion of the Tract, implicitly or explicitly, as a public park.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLESON, TEXAS, THAT:**

**Section 1.**

Without dedicating any portion of the Tract, implicitly or explicitly, as a public park or recreational area, the potential community park on the Tract is hereby named "Burleson Legacy Park."

**Section 2.**

This resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
