Purpose

- FAA requires updated agreement for long-term access
- Supports continued operation of federal equipment at the airport
- Ensures compliance with national airspace system requirements





MOA Overview

- Parties: FAA and City of Burnet
- Term: Oct. 1, 2025 Sept. 30, 2045
- Facilities:
 - PAPI Runway 19
 - ASOS Airport Grounds & Terminal building
- No cost to the City





Key Terms

- FAA has right to maintain and access equipment
- City may review/comment on installation or changes
- FAA responsible for their own facility costs and maintenance
- City agrees not to interfere with FAA operations
