- 3. \$25,000 increase in BEDC expenses for Christmas Decorations.
- 4. \$20,000 increase in Police expenses for purchase of Lenslock camera system.
- 5. \$20,000 increase in General fund capital expenses for additional eclipse planning expenses.
- 6. \$501,155 increase in Self-funded equipment for the early purchase of 83 new golf carts.
- 7. \$36,495 increase in Self-funded equipment for the early purchase of new vehicle for the Police department.
- 8. \$40,000 increase in Water/WW expenses for early start of TCEQ wastewater plant permit renewal process.

- 15. \$144,135 increase in Fire department personnel expenses to add 4 new fulltime EMT/Firefighters.
- 16. \$15,000 increase in Water/WW capital budget to purchase SCADA for Eagle's Nest.
- 17. \$37,500 increase in Electric capital budget for next feeder of electric system mapping proposal.
- 18. \$14,500 increase Water/WW capital budget for a study of the City's impact fees.
- 19. \$20,650 increase in General capital budget for purchase of 50 new barricades.
- 20. \$39,000 increase in General capital budget for purchase of Trunarc equipment for the Police department.

- 21. \$640,456 increase in Electric capital budget for subdivision electrical costs paid for by developers.
- 22. \$5,267 increase in Electric capital budget for new meters covered by new connect fees.
- 23. \$332,500 increase in Electric expenses for increase in cost of power expense covered by increased electric revenues.
- 24. \$22,625 increase in pro shop cogs and \$37,225 increase in snack bar cogs covered by increased pro shop and snack bar revenues.
